

What is a Power Slide SM?

 A communication process detailing key information for the day's lesson in an effort to frame student thinking.



What does a Power SlideSM include?

- Learning targets ("I can" statements in student friendly language, and lesson-sized)
- Agenda
- Check in, Check on, Check out process that sets expectations for accountability



Why use a Power Slide SM?

- Teaching and learning roadmap
- Consistency (when used daily)
- Clear expectations that frame student thinking
- Provides curriculum clarity
- Details ongoing formative assessment
- Transparent accountability for learning

Teaching Learning Succeeding

Check In, Check On, Check Out

Through the Power Slide SM format teachers consider formative assessment as:

- Check-in: Are they ready to get it?
- Check-on: Are they getting it?
- Check-out: Did they get it? Are they ready for tomorrow?



Power Slide SM Checklist

My Power Slide ^{sм} has
 □ Learning Target in the form of an "I can" statement □ Can students answer, "What will I be learning today and how will I show it?" □ Are the learning targets lesson-sized? □ Do the verbs convey to students what they need to do with their learning?
 ☐ Check in to assess previous comprehension and activate prior knowledge ☐ Will the check in demonstrate if students are ready for today?
 Check on to monitor progress during the lesson toward the learning target Will the check ons tell the teacher and the students where students are in their progress toward the learning targets?
 ☐ Check out to determine who learned what ☐ Is the check out directly aligned with the learning target(s)? ☐ Will the teacher be able to use this information to inform tomorrow's instruction?
 ■ Agenda listed briefly to provide an overview of the process and when students will be held accountable ■ Do students know how they will practice the learning target(s)? ■ Are all agenda items directly aligned with the learning target(s)?
 Power Slide SM is visible during the lesson often appearing more than once in a lesson □ Do I have a plan for reprising my Power Slide SM before, during, and after the lesson?
