

Subject: English Language Arts Grade Level: Elementary School DI Strategy: Scaffolding

Writing an Autobiography Scaffolding Lesson

My students were asked to write an autobiography. This was a daunting task for elementaryaged students, so I created multiple instruction sheets for my students to use as scaffolds when creating and editing their project. The scaffolding worksheets are attached below.

The first set of scaffolds provided students with a list of potential topics that could be included in each of the sections of the autobiography. It also included a checklist to use when editing each component of their autobiography. After completing each section, students needed to have their work checked by me before moving on.

The next document provides the students with a graphic organizer on how to set up their wiki page and how to link it to each component of their autobiography.

The final document gives the students text and picture-based instructions on how the link the images on their wiki page to each component of their autobiography.

For each set of scaffolds, I did a pre-assessment to determine who would receive the scaffolds and who was already working at the correct level of difficulty and did not need additional support.



## GRAPHIC ORGANIZER FOR WIKI AUTO BIOGRAPHY


